God sent Jesus, His only Son, as His gift to us, born in a stable.




In those days Mary set out and went with haste to a Judean town in the hill country, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth.

This is the Gospel of the Lord Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ This gift of God, Jesus, was born to a young woman.


His earthly father was a poor carpenter, not a royal king with fine clothes and palaces.
